

Descendants of Edward Doyle (5)

1. **Edward Doyle** (5) was born on 21 Jan 1858 Laheen South, Mohill, Co Leitrim.¹ He was baptized Mohill R.C. Church, Co Leitrim, on 21 Jan 1858. Religion: Roman Catholic.² He married **Elizabeth Reynolds** (8), daughter of **Michael Reynolds** (69), on 12 Feb 1885 Bornacoola R.C. Church, Knockadranan, Co Leitrim. The Bridesmaid was Ellen Molaghan while the Bestman was **John Doyle** (70).³

He died on 11 Mar 1934 Clooncarne, Co Leitrim, aged 76. Edward's stated age at death was 70, which suggests a birth year of 1864. He was however born in 1857/58, which indicates how unreliable stated ages at death can be. The cause of death was Bronchial Asthma and Cardiac Failure.⁴

He was buried circa 12 Mar 1934 Cloonmorris R.C. Cemetery, Co Leitrim.⁵

Edward (5), resided with his parents **Nicholas Doyle** (6) and **Bridget Wynne** (7), Laheen South, Mohill, Co Leitrim, from 21 Jan 1858 to 1864.⁶

Edward (5), resided with his parents **Nicholas Doyle** (6) and **Bridget Wynne** (7) Clooncarne, Co Leitrim, on 24 Mar 1867.⁷ He resided Clooncarne, Co Leitrim, from 1867 to 1934.

He attended school from 10 Oct 1870 to 30 Jun 1874 Clooneagh National School, Co Leitrim.⁸

He witnessed the death of **Nicholas Doyle** (6) on 18 Nov 1890 Clooncarne, Co Leitrim.⁹

He is shown as the listed holder Clooncarne in 1892, on the Cancelled Land Books of the Valuation Office.¹⁰

He was listed as head of household in the 1901 census Clooncarne, Co Leitrim.¹¹

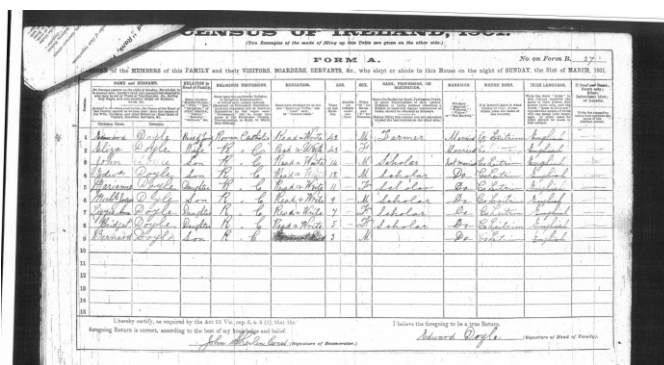

According to the 1901 Census Edward's house was a 2nd class house (2 doors, 3 windows in front) with 5 outhouses.¹² He was listed as head of household in the 1911 census Clooncarne, Co Leitrim.¹³

Edward Doyle (5) was described as being a small, round, fat man in his later years.¹⁴

The seven known children of **Edward Doyle (5)** and **Elizabeth Reynolds (8)** all born Clooncarne, Co Leitrim, were as follows:



- 2 i. John Doyle (2) was born on 7 Jan 1886.¹⁵ He was baptized Bornacoola R.C. Church, Knockadrinan, Co Leitrim, on 7 Jan 1886. Religion: Roman Catholic.¹⁶ John Doyle (2) married Mary Diffley (3), daughter of James Diffley (20) and Catherine Kilrane (64), on 9 Jun 1924 Bornacoola R.C. Church, Knockadrinan, Co Leitrim, He died on 10 Apr 1975 Clooncarne, Co Leitrim, aged 89.¹⁷ He was buried on 12 Apr 1975 Cloonmorris R.C. Cemetery, Co Leitrim.¹⁸

John (2) was listed on the roll as a student Clooneagh National School, Co Leitrim, from Apr 1894 to 28 Feb 1902.¹⁹ He was listed as a member of the household of Edward Doyle (5) in the 1901 census Clooncarne, Co Leitrim.²⁰ He was listed as a member of the household of Edward Doyle (5) in the 1911 census Clooncarne, Co Leitrim.²¹

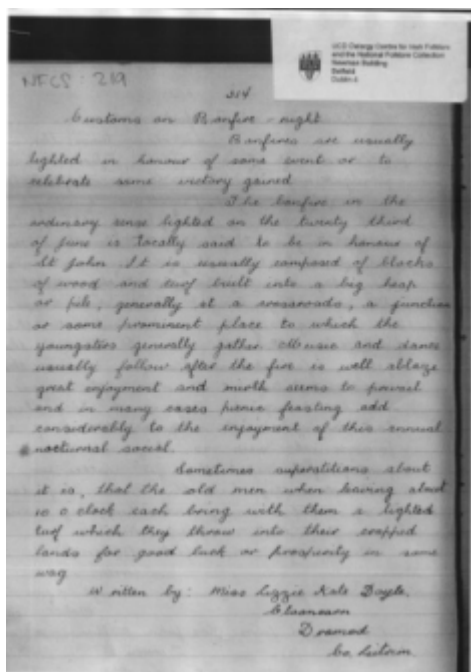

He was listed as the Land Holder on the Valuation Office records in 1933 Clooncarne, Co Leitrim, He replaced Edward as the registered occupier.²²

John Doyle (2) supplied the information that his daughter Elizabeth (10) wrote in the Clooneagh School collection for the Schools Folklore Collection, entitled "Customs on Bonfire Night".²³



He witnessed the burial of Mary Diffley (3) circa 10 Mar 1971 Cloonmorris R.C. Cemetery, Co Leitrim.²⁴

- 3 ii. Edward Doyle (12) was born on 31 Oct 1887.²⁵ His birth was registered in the Rinn Sub-District in the Mohill registration district.²⁶ He married Ann Doherty (61) after 1 Jan 1920 New York; Ann was a cousin of Helen who married Bernard. It is virtually certain the couple had no family.²⁷ He died circa 1960 New York.²⁸
- 4 iii. Mary Anne Doyle (14) was born on 10 May 1889.²⁹ She died circa 1945 U.S.A.. Mary Anne died of an accident though the exact year is unknown. She is believed to have been unmarried at time of death.³⁰
- 5 iv. Michael Joseph Doyle (13) was born on 6 Jun 1891.³¹ He married Annie Fanning (62), daughter of Hugh Fanning (91) and Catherine Guckian (92), on 12 May 1918 U.S.A.³² He died on 12 Apr 1975 New York aged 83. Michael died 2 days after his elder brother John. However, the SSDI shows a suitably aged Michael Doyle who died in August 1977.³³

- 6 v. Elizabeth Anne Doyle (17) was born on 4 Jan 1893.³⁴ She married John McDermott (54), son of Michael McDermott (89) and Mary Unknown (88), in 1926 Bornacoola R.C. Church, Knockadranan, Co Leitrim.³⁵ She died on 6 Feb 1978 Mohill Hospital, Co Leitrim, aged 85. Cause of death was Broncho Pneumonia, Cardio Vascular Occident.³⁶

- 7 vi. Bridget Doyle (9) was born on 5 Sep 1894.³⁸ She married Timothy McDermott (53), son of Patrick McDermott (151) and Kate McGarry (152), between Oct 1924 and Dec 1924 Bornacoola R.C. Church, Knockadranan, Co Leitrim.³⁹ She died on 15 Oct 1978 St Patrick's Hospital, Carrick-on-Shannon, aged 84.⁴⁰ She was buried on 17 Oct 1978 Mohill Graveyard, Co Leitrim.⁴¹
- 8 vii. Bernard Doyle (11) was born on 25 Aug 1896.⁴² He married Helen Doherty (63) in 1925 New York.⁴³ He died in May 1975 Westchester, White Plains City, aged 78.⁴⁴
