

Individual Narrative of Edward Doyle (5)

Edward Doyle (5) was born on 21 Jan 1858 at Laheen South, Mohill.¹ He was baptized at Mohill, on 21 Jan 1858. Religion: Roman Catholic.³

Edward (5), resided with his parents **Nicholas Doyle** (6) and **Bridget Wynne** (7), at Laheen South, Mohill, from 21 Jan 1858 to 1864.²

He resided at Clooncarne, Mohill, from 1867 to 1934.⁴ He resided with his parents **Nicholas Doyle** (6) and **Bridget Wynne** (7) at Clooncarne, on 24 Mar 1867.⁵ He attended school from 10 Oct 1870 to 30 Jun 1874 at Clooneagh, Mohill.⁶

He married **Elizabeth Reynolds** (8), daughter of **Michael Reynolds** (69), on 12 Feb 1885 at Knockadrinan, Mohill. The Bridesmaid was Ellen Molaghan while the Bestman was **John Doyle** (70).⁷

He witnessed the death of **Nicholas Doyle** (6) on 18 Nov 1890 at Clooncarne, Mohill.⁸

He is shown as the listed holder at Clooncarne in 1892, on the Cancelled Land Books of the Valuation Office.²

He was listed as head of household in the 1901 census at Clooncarne, Mohill. According to the 1901 Census Edward's house was a 2nd class house (2 doors, 3 windows in front) with 5 outhouses.⁹ He was listed as head of household in the 1911 census at Clooncarne.¹⁰

Edward Doyle (5) was described as being a small, round, fat man in his later years.¹¹

He died on 11 Mar 1934 at Clooncarne, Mohill, aged 76. Edward's stated age at death was 70, which suggests a birth year of 1864. He was however born in 1857/58, which indicates how unreliable stated ages at death can be. The cause of death was Bronchial Asthma and Cardiac Failure.⁸

He was buried circa 12 Mar 1934 at Cloonmorris, Mohill.¹²
